WAR RISKS – REVISIONS TO THE LIST OF AREAS OF PERCEIVED ENHANCED RISK

In accordance with the Terms of Entry for Hull and Machinery War Risks including “Navigation Limitations for Hull War, Strikes, Terrorism and Related Perils Endorsement (JW2005/001A)”, Notice of Cancellation is hereby given in order to amend the List of Areas of Perceived Enhanced Risk currently in “JWC Hull War, Strikes, Terrorism and Related Perils Listed Areas (7 August 2006)”.

The new List of Areas of Perceived Enhanced Risk is attached in “JWC Hull War, Strikes, Terrorism and Related Perils Listed Areas (2 May 2008)”.

The following area is added:

Gulf of Aden transit, area as defined as bounded by Longitude 45°E to the West, Latitude 15°N to the North, Longitude 57°E to the East and Latitude 10°N to the South but vessels or craft are not to approach within 100 nautical miles of the Socotra Archipelago and are to stay at least 40 nautical miles to the north of Somalia whilst transiting the Gulf of Aden but excluding the territorial waters of other countries.

In addition the following area is amended:-

Somalia, including waters out to 200 nautical miles of the eastern (Indian Ocean) coast. Vessels or craft are not to approach within 100 nautical miles of the Socotra Archipelago and are to stay at least 40 nautical miles to the north of Somalia when transiting the Gulf of Aden (west of 45°E) but excluding the territorial waters of other countries.

This notice is effective from 24:00 Hours British Summer Time 13 May 2008 and will therefore, in accordance with contract terms, become effective at 24:00 Hours British Summer Time 20 May 2008.

This contract shall be considered as automatically reinstated upon expiry of the notice period, subject to the Listed Areas being amended to reflect “JWC Hull War, Strikes, Terrorism and Related Perils Listed Areas (2 May 2008)”. All other terms, clauses and conditions remain unaltered.

Notice must be given to the Company before an Entered Ship proceeds into a Listed Area as defined in “JWC Hull War, Strikes, Terrorism and Related Perils Listed Areas (2 May 2008)”. The company will endeavour to provide indications of additional premium levels at any time but quotations will not normally be available until the Entered Ship is within 48 hours of arrival into the Listed Area.
